Step by Step

STEP ONE

The experience starts at our shop in Royal Tunbridge Wells. We will show you all the Perazzi models available, carry out an initial fitting and discuss what engraving you have in mind.

STEP TWO

We send your gun spec to Perazzi who start crafting your gun.

STEP THREE

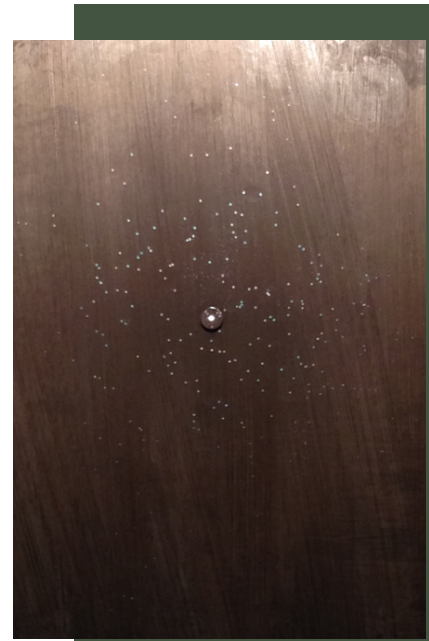
We fly you to the Perazzi factory in Botticino, Italy for your gun fitting. You will use the indoor pattern plate to test the fit and any adjustments can be made.

STEP FOUR

It's time to choose your wood! This can be a hard choice and it is a very personal choice – What colour? What about the weight of the wood which is crucial to the balance of the gun? Well, our staff and the Perazzi team are on hand to share their knowledge and help you make the right choice to produce the gun perfectly balanced for you.

STEP FIVE

After a leisurely supper at a local trattoria and a glass or two of vino, you return to the factory the following day to see your cut and shaped stock and test again at the pattern plate before returning home to wait in anticipation for delivery of your bespoke gun.



Frequently Asked Questions

How long before my gun is delivered?

As the gun is bespoke to you it can take nine months for a standard black action gun to two years for a hand engraved sideplate SCO gun.

What are the grades of Perazzi?

There are several grades from a black standard action and standard walnut stock to hand engraving with choices of wood grade.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the difference between an MX8 and MX12?

The MX8 was originally designed for trap shooting, firing bottom then top barrel and with a detachable trigger unit to allow the shooter to change or replace springs in high level competition (mainly V-springs, can be made with coil springs on request).

The MX12 is designed primarily for sporting and game shooting with the ability to select barrels and using coil springs for consistent reliability. It has been a very popular choice since its launch in 1996

What is the difference between an MX2000 and and MX2000S?

The MX2000 is based on the MX8 (see above).

The MX2000S is based on the MX12 (see above).

What is the difference between a High Tech and a High Tech S?

The High Tech is based on the MX8.

The High Tech S is based on the MX12.

Can I get an autosafe?

Yes, it is an upgrade option at the time of ordering.

What will my bespoke gun weigh?

It will depend on the specification, Perazzis aren't light guns but the balance and handling is superb. Average weight 7.5-8lbs.

Is Perazzi family owned?

Yes, by the Perazzi family since 1957.

How often should I get my Perazzi serviced?

Every 30,000 shots or every two years, whichever comes first.

How often should I clean my Perazzi?

After every use.



Frequently Asked Questions

Do Olympians win with Perazzis?

Yes, they are very successful! At London 2012 Perazzi shooters won 12 out of 15 medals available. Perazzi have won more Olympic medals than any other manufacturer.

Are Perazzis steel proofed?

Since 2019, all Perazzis have been superior steel proofed with at least the CIP S mark. They can be proofed for high performance steel (Fleur de Lys) if required.
